Gentlemen:

On the 35th I am sending a can via sea mail insured. Inside is another can labeled Charcoal from the Southwest Rift of Haleakala. Inside the second can are four samples marked as follows.

Mahoe: Single chunk of 33 grams wrapped in coarse paper.

Makua: Two plastic containers each of 9 grams of bits.


Keonehunehune: Two plastic containers each of 9 grams of bits.

Pimoe: Round metal box with 25 grams pieces of root and bark.

All this material is thoroly carbonized and should be ample to produce the six grams of carbon you need. Do not throw any excess charcoal away. Please put the unused portion back in proper containers and fill up empty space with tissue paper to prevent rattling. Then ship the remains to me at Green Bank.

On the 29th I am leaving for the west coast. When it is time to pay the money, please advise me at Green Bank and I will have Research Corporation send a suitable check.
