Dear Reber,

There are two things which I would very much appreciate if you could for me whilst in America, we can arrange the question of reimbursement to our mutual satisfaction when you return.

1. Teledeltos Tape

This is obtainable from Western Union Telegraph Co., 60 Hudson St., N.Y. 13, New York. We have written to them and had no reply, but so far as we can make out it is normally supplied in 3" rolls 500' long. If it is available immediately we would like 1½" rolls 1000' long but do not spend any time getting them cut and wound specially, i.e. take what you can get off the shelves. What we would like is 6, 1½" (or 3") rolls immediately and a quotation of price and delivery for a considerable supply, e.g. 200 rolls.

2. Crystal Filter for General Radio Wave Analyser.

Ever since we have had this Analyser it has possessed an intermittent fault which causes the gain to drop about 30 d.b. We obtained from the local agents specifications of all the potentials and components etc. and these appear to be all in order, so that as far as we can determine the fault is in one or other of the crystals. I understand that you have a spare set and if these are in working order perhaps you could bring them back with you. Alternatively could you arrange to borrow a set from the General Radio Company.
