I'm gradually working through paper on interpretations of spectra, and time variability... I couldn't afford to get all of figure 4 (spectra) reproduced so I've included a sample.

We saw a copy of your paper with George Brandie (via Green Bank) on the 8000 MHz survey, and thought we might try to observe MA 1535 +00 (since it's not too faint & available now), but on measuring optical position found it was 8.5 and 3.1 arcseconds off the radio position (in RA and dec. resp.).
