Dear John,

I am writing in connection with the paper '14.8-GHz mapping of the extended radio core in NGC 1167', by myself and Ed Fomalont, M.N. reference H.2148, which has been accepted for publication as a Short Communication. I understand that you will be checking the proofs.

The Editorial Assistant drew our attention to an unused reference, that to Olsen (1970), which has been generated by a clerical error. Please amend the first sentence of the second paragraph of the text to read as follows:

NGC 1167 (= 0258+350) has been recognised as a radio galaxy since its identification with 4C34.09 (Aizu 1966; Caswell and Wills 1967; Wills 1967a; Olsen 1970).

Also, in the sixth line from the bottom of p.4 of the text, amend 'center' to the British spelling.

I apologise for these errors, but we were unable to double-check the final version of the paper due to postal disruptions in the U.S. and in Canada.


