Dear Grote,

If I remember correctly, I sent you a letter from Shannon Airport in the beginning of September to report on the successful completion of the Jodrell Bank Symposium and to ask you if you would still like to include a paper by yourself in the publication. The manuscripts for this publication are now piling up and it would be a particular satisfaction to me as an editor to have all the illustrious names in there. If you think it is not possible to send me a paper, please let me know without delay. If you think you can let me have a paper, please let me know by letter what will be the title and what number of **Figures** you think should be included. After I have this information the further work does not have to be delayed and you can take a reasonable time to prepare the paper. Halftones will not be acceptable, but anywhere between 1 and 4 line drawings would be fine. If you do not have easy accommodation to prepare the drawings for the printer, you can send clear pencil sketches.

We had the first observation with ~~our~~ new 25-m parabola in spite of the fact that it is not nearly ready for regular operation as the drives are not in yet. Seeger observed the occultation of the Crab nebula by the moon and found it to be just about the size of the optical nebula and not twice as big.
