Cancellations will be notified on the Excursion Notice Board in the Registration Centre at 5.30 p.m. on the day before the excursion except for Excursions 21 and 50, for which it will be posted before 1 p.m. on the 16th if necessary. Refund of fees for cancelled minor excursions will be made after the Congress by post.
