1965 July 9 AHB returns to Cambridge from vacation in Austria, working on second draft of scaled array background spectrum paper for MNRAS, supervised by John Baldwin

1965 July 16 CRP returns to Cambridge from DRAO. Tells AHB "strong possibility someone will be needed to look for radio sources with the 10-MHz array" as ionospheric conditions continue to be excellent at 22 MHz. AHB expresses interest.

1965 July 22 CRP and PAGS give colloquium on 10-MHz project at Cavendish Laboratory.

AHB definitely interested in going to DRAO to continue the 10 MHz work "but Martin (Ryle) must be convinced before that comes off"

Financial support for DRAO visit requested from Royal Society, status unknown.

CRP brings AHB up to speed on operational details of 10 MHz array, phasing, network, receivers, etc.

Dinner at Malcolm Longair's with PAGS and CRP - much discussion about 10 MHz and Penticton.

1965 Aug 3 Another iteration with Baldwin on scaled array paper, effect of absorption in ground screen being discussed.

1965 Aug 4 AHB and CRP discuss living in Penticton, AHB lack of driver license a problem.

1965 Aug 5 Royal Society declines to fund a second year of 10 MHZ observing project.

1965 Aug 6 Malcolm Longair and AHB host "Gotterdammerung" in Arthur Eddington's former rooms in Great Court, Trinity College.

1965 Aug 8 continuing rewriting of scaled array paper.

1965 Aug 13 PAGS tells AHB to go ahead with planning to go to Canada by Cunard and then across Canada by Canadian Pacific train.

1965 Aug 14 AHB has Ryle's comments on scaled array paper, given go-ahead to submit.

1965 Aug 16 PAGS telephones John Galt to discuss logistics of AHB presence at DRAO

1965 Aug 17 John Galt contacts PAGS and CRP to give go ahead for AHB to go to DRAO. AHB books passage on "Franconia" from Southampton to Montreal with personal check from PAGS.
