Dear Mr. Dolphin:

For the past several years I have been doing work on cosmic static as an individual. The enclosed reprint from "Observatory" describes the general field and provides numerous references.

Last summer I joined the Bureau to undertake a comprehensive investigation of celestial radio waves. At the present time the program is still being organized. We are looking for people with experience and enthusiasm in this new branch of science. However, since you are not an American citizen, there may be some difficulty in considering you for our organization. We are investigating the matter now.

In the meantime, I suggest that you contact the National Research Council of Canada at Ottawa. They are conducting solar radio investigations under the direction of A. E. Covington who is in the micro-wave section.
