Thanks for your letter. The <sup>dates</sup> seem very nice, and the new one for the West Point Lighthouse -south fits in well with the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  thousand for W.P. north. I had noticed the <sup>typographical</sup> mistake in the other one.

I am at present working on the stones from Rocky Cape in order to try and get and get something to say at A.N.Z.A.A.S. I had given the article to Richard Wright for publication in 'Mankind', and I believe that he is writing to you at present.

I am thinking of going to West Point just after ANZAAS for about a week, and stay at the Murphy's shack. Alan Thorne ~~who~~ is doing an M.A. on the human material from the site, and from 1 cremation pit <sup>he</sup> has reconstructed the back half of a skull, and this is associated with bits of jaw as well. All the pieces were freshly broken after having been burnt, and it is possible that there may be some more bits lying around in the vicinity of the pit. We have found quite a lot of a different individual ~~bi~~ lying around nearby at the same stratigraphic level, and there might be a one third chance of finding some more. Anyway, I want to see the West Coast in Winter!

Thanks very much for the air photos, they were excellent. I look forward to seeing you in Hobart this August.
