Thank you for your letter of the 20th which found its way to me here. Apparently you wish me to suggest something interesting to do with the radar antenna. Probably it would be most suitable for monitoring solar radio waves. Perhaps you could tip the vertical axis to point toward the south celestial pole. The device would then follow the sum during the day. Some adjustment would need to be incorporated for change in solar declination with the seasons. The electronics required would depend on wavelength chosen. Mr. Covington would be most able to make suggestions on this subject.
