In accordance with your letter of 31st March I am sending by separate air mail a small package with charcoal taken from the bottom of an aboriginal kitchen midden at South Arm, Hobart, Tasmania, Australia. This seems to be the first attempt to gain any knowledge of these people by this method.

Most of the charcoal is in fine pieces. However there are a few larger pieces. I suggest that you use the largest pieces first (if possible, one piece only) as this will produce a more uniform sample than an assortment of the smaller pieces.

I think I will be back in Green Bank before you complete the analysis. Please advise me of the results there and return any unused charcoal to me, addressed:
