Your reprint on "A Precision Radio Time Signal System" has found its way to me here. Thanks very much.

Last spring I left the Bureau of Standards where the opportunities seemed quite limited to have a go at it on my own again. Most of the past nine months I've spent in Hawaii where I have been fortunate in locating and obtaining the use of the top of an old volcano nearly two miles high. Nearly all the way around the horizon is water so it should be a good place to do Lloyds mirror experiments. Furthermore at the latitude of Maui all the Milkyway rises from and sets into the sea.

Within a few weeks I expect to return to the Islands and complete the construction work sometime this summer.
