Dear Warren.

Thanks for your interesting and cordial letter of the 18th April. Thanks also for the two bucks. They are the first American money I've seen in a long time and will be put to good use soon. The old microphone was packed with two inches of crushed paper all around and sent off en 24th, marked as I've previously indicated. The mike should still be in good working condition. I understand this mechanical design was used very early when mike was placed in antenna lead. The R.F. from oscillator passed through mike on way to antenna. The varying resistance of mike caused downward modulation of antenna current. Powers up to a few tens of watts could be modulated about thirty percent before mike overheated and carbons stuck.

There has been a change in my plans as there seems to be some urgency that I get back to New York promptly. Consequently the trip to Penticton has been cancelled and I fly direct via Los Angeles leaving here soon. My address as of the 15th will be
