Water Production and Distribution

The *water distribution* system has no year 2000 sensitive equipment. LACUD has been in contact with the SCADA system vendor for the *water production* system and determined there is a year 2000 problem with the SCADA system. The corrected software is scheduled to be installed by late spring or early summer, 1999. The Department is presently completing a survey of the other, non-SCADA water system electronic equipment to determine if there are any other problems.

Meter Reading/Billing System

SFG, the Los Alamos County computer software vendor, has provided the County with Y2K upgrades for all of their subsystems including utility billing. These upgrades have been loaded on the Department's machines and are ready for testing. LACUD plans to have testing completed by March, 1999. Several other cities have completed their testing of the SFG Y2K software and have found it to work properly.

Summary

The Los Alamos County Utilities Department wants to assure you that the Department's goal is to provide reliable service to our customers. LACUD will continue to direct a great deal of effort to the Y2K issue during 1999, with testing and verification deadlines set for the end of the third quarter, 1999.
