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Thanks for your letter of the 14th. Please keep me on your mailing list to receive quarterly reports of your locm radiations. Presently all I do is file them. However they are a good index of solar activity and from time to time I look to see what you got on some specific day.

Since I saw you in Washington I changed the operating frequency to 50mc with a substantial improvement in results. Next I expect to get up to 100mc and see what will be secured. Gradually I am beginning to understand this thing. As usual, when I get to this point I begin to lose interest in the experiment.

My visit to Ottawa is merely delayed, not cancelled. Right now I am negotiating with the people in Tasmania to try a long wave experiment down there. If things turn out as hoped, I'll be there for about a year starting next October.
