

I am pleased to write and confirm that the Council of the Royal Astronomical Society at its meeting last Friday awarded you the Jackson-Gwilt Medal and Gift of the Society. The award was made in recognition of your pioneering work in radio astronomy. The Gift is £100.

The President, on behalf of the Society, would like to present the medal to you at one of the Society's meetings. The meeting days during the remainder of this year are February 11, March 11, April 8 (the out-of-town meeting at Keele), May 13, October 14, November 11 and December 9.
