Thank you for your letter of 28/3/62. The description you give of my activities is quite flattering. I didn't know I was that good! I will be happy to have this synopsis of my career published in the form you have drawn up.

It is my plan to leave here about 22nd August and return shortly before the end of September. If the ASP gathering at Berkeley could be arranged for a date during the last ten days of September, it would be most convenient for me. I will be happy to attend, receive the Bruce Medal and make a short reply.

The crossarms, hardware and insulators are being fitted to my array of poles. A few wires have been put up and some satisfactory electrical tests performed.

I have been watching the results of the routine ionosphere measurement here. Already about half the nights show an hour or more of transparency at 141 meters wavelength. The coming winter should provide very good conditions.
