Dear Dr. Helms,

Thank you for your letter of the 19th December which arrived today. My observations of cosmic static at two megacycles and those of Professor Ellis at five megacycles are complete day and night over the past year or more. Probably the best way to proceed on this matter is for you to select about three dozen observations over Tasmania, preferably during the southern winter months. Within this group should be considerable variation of the trough phenomenon, i.e. not all observations alike. We will then compare your data with ours and advise you of our findings.
