In 1978, the IIT Trustees launched a \$100 Million Development Program in support of the university's long-range endowment, operational and campus enhancement needs. To date, more than \$58 million has been committed to this campaign.

As Chairman of the National Alumni Capital Campaign, I am charged with the responsibility of securing \$30 million from alumni by December, 1986 and am pleased to be able to report that \$18 million has already been realized -- evidence of the tremendous loyalty IIT alumni have toward their alma mater.

During the next six months, I plan to meet with small groups of alumni throughout the nation for the purpose of identifying those alumni who might be able to make significant commitments to IIT.
